

Extended 8th Directive filing deadline

COM(2010) 381

HMRC has announced on its website that the EU Member States have unanimously supported the Commission's proposal to extend the deadline for the submission of 2009 8th Directive VAT refund claims to 31 March 2011. The announcement goes on to say that implementing legislation is expected to be adopted in early October and will apply retrospectively from 1 October.
