

## **Incoterms 2010**

[Incoterms 2010 published](#). The International Chamber of Commerce has recently published its revised International Commerce Terms, Incoterms 2010 which take effect and can be incorporated into contracts from 1 January 2011. Incoterms are voluntary, but widely used in international commerce, to define the passing of risk and ownership.

Incoterms 2010 do not include the terms DAF, DES, DEQ and DDU which are replaced by the terms DAT (Delivered at Terminal) and DAP (Delivered at Place). The grouping of terms has also been much simplified.

Incoterms 2010 includes additions relating to security clearances, as well as division of costs between buyer and seller.
