

Alcohol Warehouse Registration Scheme – regulations published

The purpose of the Alcohol Wholesaler Registration Scheme is to reduce the risk of illicit alcohol, on which no duty has been paid, being sold to unsuspecting consumers. To be approved under the scheme, traders wanting to wholesale alcohol will have to pass rigorous checks and in 2017, the scheme will also provide a facility for retailers to check whether their suppliers are approved.
