

Customs Compliance Conference – UCC Implementing Act & Delegating Act

The Union Customs Code Implementing Act and Delegating Act were adopted by the EU Commission in July 2015. The deadline for objections from the EU Parliament and Council of Ministers was 21 October 2015. This passed without any objection.

The relevant provisions will therefore take effect on 1 May 2016 and there will be no delay in implementation. Businesses need to ensure compliance with the new Code now to be ready for 1 May.
